1. Make sure students have what they need to log in

All students will need:

- **A PowerUp-ready device** (computer or iPad)
- **Headphones or earbuds.**
- **Login information:** A printed login card for each student ready for distribution. (see step 4)
- **Access to the PowerUp Student Program** (via iPad app or with the school's custom URL)

2. Introduce your students to PowerUp

3. Prepare for Auto Placement

- Students will start [Auto Placement](#) activities the first time they log in to PowerUp.
- Students can complete the three-part PowerUp Auto Placement in approximately 30 minutes. **Note** that students can complete the Comprehension placement activity over multiple sittings, but will need to complete each of the Word Study and Grammar placement activities in one sitting.
- Students should be supervised while they complete Auto Placement.
- Encourage your students to do their best work so they will be placed at a level in the program that is just right for them!
- When they finish PowerUp Auto Placement, students are taken to their placement level and are able to begin working.

4. Time to log in!

- **Provide log in cards only after Lexia and the Auto Placement have been fully introduced.**
- **Logging in on a web browser:** Have students navigate to lexiapowerup.com or your school's custom link for PowerUp. [Learn more about custom links.](#)
- **Logging in on an iPad:** Have students open the PowerUp app on the iPad.
- **Students should be supported throughout the session by a trained member of staff.**

5. Make sure your students know how to log out.

- When it is time to stop working, show your students how to log out of PowerUp
- Look for the logout button in the upper right of the PowerUp window. Students will need to confirm log out so they get back to the log in screen.
- When students log out of PowerUp, they will get credit for all the minutes they spent in the program. If they don't log out, some minutes may not be recorded.
- Make sure to visit myLexia to access useful reports and resources.
