


About the data

The findings in this report are based on data from **37,474 students** across **600 primary schools**, collected between **September 2024 and July 2025**.



Weekly Usage and Progress

Regular engagement with Lexia Core5 is strongly associated with accelerated reading development.

The 2024–2025 data shows that students who maintained recommended weekly usage made progress well beyond typical expectations for their age, an average of **15 months** overall*.

Lexia Core5 Usage Overview

The link between progress and programme usage is clear: students who use Lexia Core5 regularly achieve the greatest outcomes.

Targeted Usage: Pupils who maintained the recommended 60 minutes per week of Core5 practice not only met the expected usage guidelines but also achieved the highest reading gains, with an average total of **3,715 minutes over the year**, approximately **1 hour and 30 minutes** per school week. This consistent, sustained engagement directly underpins the accelerated progress highlighted earlier, enabling students to exceed typical age-related expectations and make an average of **15 months' progress in reading**.

Average Student Usage: Across all pupils, average engagement reached 1,112 minutes per year, around 28 minutes per school week. Across this group, students made an average of 6.3 months' reading progress, demonstrating that even modest, consistent engagement with Lexia Core5 contributes to meaningful literacy growth. While outcomes are strongest for those meeting the recommended 60 minutes per week, this data highlights that any regular practice helps build reading skills and supports ongoing development.

In summary: Pupils who met the recommended usage made, on average, over **8 months more progress** in reading than those with lower levels of engagement, a clear indication that consistent use is the key driver of literacy success.


*Months of Growth (approx.) figure converts students' "units gained" in Core5 into a time-based measurement to understand student progress. In order to complete four levels (1 year equivalent) over a standard 10-month school year, students need to complete about 28 units per month. Months of growth approx. = student's units gained out of 28.



Student Attainment

Lexia Core5 not only accelerates reading progress but also helps students achieve and exceed literacy benchmarks. The data shows a significant increase in age-related attainment with consistent and prolonged use of the program.

These outcomes are particularly noteworthy for younger students in Key Stage I, where early intervention and support can have the most dramatic impact, with **94%** of pupils meeting their age-related benchmark

For Upper Key Stage 2 students, while the percentage meeting benchmarks is lower (29%), it's important to consider that these students often have more significant gaps to close.


